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| Fundraiser(s) | Major fundraiser for the year is Christmas outdoor market. Originally, chocolate sales were harnessed to get goal of \$6,000 to \$8,000 for school. Computers now need replacing, and extra funds We have 212 families (340 students), we need about 30\$ per child/40\$ for family. Christmas market – Thursday December 2nd – 6 -7pm for JK to 3, 7-8pm for Grade 4-8. Wanted outdoors to ensure no cancellation (and will help because Christmas concert can't be held indoors due to COVID). Idea is to sell to families a passport for the evening. Students and volunteers would turn the field into an outdoor market. Outdoor vendors would come to allow students to buy Christmas gifts for family members. Custodian son has a pizza truck and has been hired for the event. Details include photo studio, Santa snaps, hot chocolate booths, carnival game area, vendors Goal is to build community as well as fundraise money. Hopefully students can participate in an outdoor concert as well. School needs parents to join in and take on specific responsibilities such as approaching vendors for donations, sending in charitable donations, lending equipment (e.g., outdoor heaters) Survey form may be developed Keely extra thought: Maybe classes can be given certain tasks that parents can sign up for, similar to how we worked to make the raffle baskets last year? When the tasks were more directed than open, I think it was easier for parents to join in, and they didn't assume that someone else had taken care of it. | G. Borg |
